## KILKENNY NORTHERN LIGHT

A clean and refreshing ale. Good any time of year to refresh the palate and keep one's yearnings for craft-brewed beer satiated.

## LEINSTER IRISH LAGER

## MARBLE CITY RED

A nitrogenated Irish Red Ale. The deep red hue is adorned with a rich, white creamy head. Brewed with just a smidgen of hops to compliment the robust malt character and smooth finish. Kilkenny is often referred to as 'The Marble City.' The city's footpaths and many local buildings were constructed with the marble quarried nearby.

## SAINT CANICE PALE ALE

A hoppy yet well rounded Pale Ale, with a fruity hop aroma and flavor supported by a balanced malt backbone. It finishes with a strong hop dryness, encouraging the sipper to order another. Canice Cathedral is named after St. Canice, the patron saint of the shipwrecked, who also gave his name to the town Kilkenny. Cill Chainnigh is Gaelic for "Church of Canice."

A dark ale flowing from roasted aromas and flavors to a pleasant hop bitterness in the finish, a true Porter lover's favorite. The Porter style of beer is named after the vocation of its imbibers. Porters loaded and unloaded ships' cargo, then refreshed themselves with this tasty beverage.
